ATTACHMENT AND DEPLOYMENT OF THE BLANKET NAIL HANGER STRAP

The "Nail Hanger" (Fig 1) is designed to allow the user to temporarily nail the opened Tactical Blanket™ over a door, window, or wall section. The Nail Hanger can be used with or without the Aluminum Extension Pole Set (available separately).

The Hanger is provided in sets of three. When deploying a full eight panel blanket, use all three Hangers. Attach a Hanger at the top of panel #1, panel #5, and panel #8. When using less than eight panels, spread Hangers evenly across the panels.

Pull apart the Velcro® fastener strip at the top of the panel (Fig 2). Note that the Hanger has Velcro® hook on one side and loop on the other. Match up the hook and loop on the Hanger with the hook and loop on the carrier, sandwich in the carrier top seam and press closed (Fig 3). Repeat for panels #5 and #8.

For rigidity, insert the Aluminum Extension Pole into the loops provided on the face of the carrier.

Remove one of the hardened nails (glued to the face of the Hanger) and place in the pilot hole of the grommet (Fig 4). The silicone will hold the nail securely in place. Move the team and blanket into position. Place the blanket over the area to be covered and, with your free hand, hammer in the nail (Fig 5).

CAUTION: The nails provided are hardened concrete nails. Use caution when driving a hardened nail into concrete or masonry. ***If you hit the nail at an improper angle, the nail can become a projectile.***

To remove the Hangers, simply reverse the process. The nails may be "hot glued" back to the face of the Hanger.

Be certain, after removing the Hangers, that the Velcro® seam securing the ballistic panels in the carrier pockets are fully closed.

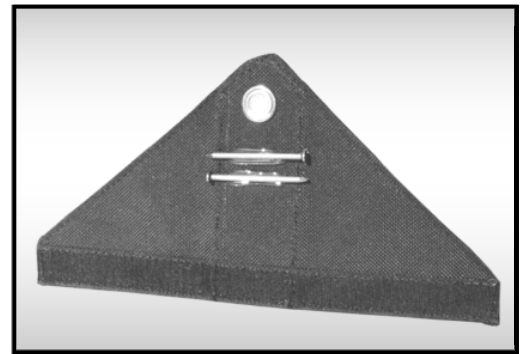
